Opening Day in early May was a great success with 50 persons in attendance. A great barbeque with plenty of refreshments was enjoyed by all.

Fish stocking for the spring has been completed with almost 1000 rainbows and 200 brook trout being introduced into the ponds. There will some additional fish added in the early fall.

Feeding was stopped in late June and will not resume until the weather cools in the late summer.

The pumps have been running steadily and this will be continued during the hot weather.

Members will note that the aerators in the south pond are not in operation. This is because of the need to run the pump and the current power line is not adequate to handle both the pump and aerator. Steps are being taken to improve service to handle both units at the same time.

Water conditions in the ponds have been a challenge. Bacterial treatment was successful in the early summer. However, heavy rains have resulted in considerable sediment runoff into the ponds. The ponds are full and are being monitored closely for levels. Temperature measurements are also recorded regularly.

Members should exercise caution when using the docks particularly on the north pond by the cleaning bench as the approach can be slippery especially when wet. Repairs are planned.
