Poachers

Unfortunately we have had another incident of poachers fishing our ponds. Can I use this as an opportunity to remind all members how you should approach suspected poachers:

- Check the Members Register and the Guest Register for persons fishing on the property
- Politely ask the suspected poacher if he/she is a new Club member or a guest?
- Ask to see his/her Club badge if not visible
- If the suspect cannot be identified as a Club member or a guest, simply and politely advise the poacher that this is private property and that he should move along and leave the Club immediately (without any fish)
- Try and record the poacher's car license number, make and colour of car as well as a brief description of the person's age, height and gender
- Pass this detail, as soon as possible, along to a member of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee will forward this information to the proper authorities

A few other Club Matters which need to be covered are:
